Minutes of the BoT Meeting

Manager Erter presented the financial report for August. There was a gross profit of \$24.45K with the cost of goods at \$25.92K for minus \$1,468 for the month. This is attributed to the large order or targets, ammunition, and reloading components received in August.

Manager Erter informed the BoT of roof repairs that will be needed for the manager's house. He was asked to have it inspected to determine the extent of the damage and cost for the repairs. A motion was made by Jerry Nickell to allow Manager Erter to proceed with the repairs not to exceed \$20K seconded by Al Miller. The motion was passed unanimously. Manager Erter will also contact our insurance agent for possible coverage.
